

US Privacy Policy

ScoresMatter, Inc, who owns and operates the ScoresMatter website ("We") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy (together with our [Terms of Use](#) and any other documents referred to in it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site www.scoresmatter.com (**our site**). This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our site, subscribing to our service, posting material or requesting further services. We may also ask you for information when you enter a competition or promotion and when you report a problem with our site.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our site and of the fulfillment of your orders.
- Details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data, whether this is required for our own billing purposes or otherwise and the resources that you access.
- Details of your results from our database following a search on the data that you provide for us to monitor on your behalf
- If you respond to any advertisement for a job, we will keep your application details until we reach a decision on it.

IP addresses and other Internet information

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

We also use Google Analytics to collect anonymous data from websites that we may advertise on. This data allows us to understand how visitors who have clicked on our advert interact with us on our website. We may also use this information to make enhancements to our website and to improve user experience. Occasionally we may share this anonymous data with our associated companies. You can opt-out of this anonymous data collection and sharing activity by visiting the Google Analytics Privacy Overview web page and following the procedures noted under the Browser Opt-out section.

Cookies

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. For detailed information on the cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them see our [Cookie Policy](#).

Where we store your personal data

We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Any payment transactions will be encrypted using SSL (Secure Sockets layer) technology. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.

Uses made of the information

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- To ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.
- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes.
- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.

- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so.
- To notify you about changes to our service.

We may share your data (but not the data from the reports that we generate for you) to carefully selected third parties. We, or the third parties may use your data to provide you with information about goods and services which may be of interest to you. We (or the third parties) may contact you about these by email, post or telephone.

If you are an existing customer, we may contact you by electronic means (e-mail or SMS) with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale to you whether those offers are from us directly or on behalf of a third party.

If you do not want us to use your data in this way, or to pass your details on to third parties for marketing purposes, please tick the relevant box situated on the form on which we collect your data (i.e. the sign up page) or let us know at any time by contacting us.

We do not disclose information about identifiable individuals to our advertisers, but we may provide them with aggregate information about our users (for example, we may inform them that 500 men aged under 30 have clicked on their advertisement on any given day). We may also use such aggregate information to help advertisers reach the kind of audience they want to target (for example, women in Atlanta). We may make use of the personal data we have collected from you to enable us to comply with our advertisers' wishes by displaying their advertisement to that target audience.

Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- Where you have opted out of marketing or have cancelled your membership with us, we may share your information with our compliance partners and marketing partners to ensure that they update their records.
- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- If ScoresMatter, Inc or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it

about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.

- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our [Terms of Use](#) or [Terms and Conditions of Membership](#) and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of ScoresMatter, Inc, Inc our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.
